BRAND STORY

April and Brian are originally from Ohio, but throughout much of Brian's professional career, he had the opportunity to work with clients in Oregon. During those work trips, he experienced Oregon Pinot noir, and it quickly became his – and April's – favorite varietal and wine-growing region.

They quickly realized that the natural beauty of this state was where they wanted to spend the second half of their lives and follow their passions and dreams of owning a vineyard and winery.

When the Sheridan property became available, it was too good of an opportunity to pass up. April and Brian bought an 88-acre property in late September 2019 with a small Pinot noir vineyard already planted. They harvested a VERY small 1.1 ton crop a few weeks later. Violet Vines was born!

In January 2022, April and Brian purchased a 5-acre cherry orchard in the Rocks District of the Milton-Freewater AVA and are in the process of converting it into a vineyard, planting Syrah, Grenache, and Mourvèdre in the Spring 2023.

The warm days and cool nights in the McMinnville AVA, paired with the unique terroir in both vineyards, allows for vibrant yet classic wines without significant new oak influence.

Winery Owners - Brian & April Zawada

Winemaker – Tim Wilson

Tim Wilson is our winemaker. Tim started his wine-making career in California, and then Washington, before realizing his dream of making Oregon Pinot Noir. In 2008, he and his wife Denise launched their own label, Denison Cellars.

Sheridan Estate Property Management – Philippe Pessereau (Atlas Vineyard Management)

Philippe Pessereau and his team at Atlas Vineyard Management farm the Sheridan property. Not only did they turn around the original vineyard, they designed and implemented the expansion.

Set in Stone Vineyard Management - Dana Dibble

Dana Dibble farms the Rocks district property, which we call the Set in Stone Vineyard. Dana has extensive experience with viticulture in Milton-Freewater, including farming his own vineyard (which is the source of our 2022 Rocks Syrah).

Portfolio

April and Brian are firm believers in show-casing the promise of the Oregon terroir and its climate. As an example, for Violet Vines' Pinot Noir, it's all about red fruit driven wine, healthy amounts of acid, no residual sugar, a pronounced mid palette, lower to moderate alcohol, a strong backbone, and a long finish.

For the Chardonnay, it's also all about the fruit – fresh, clean, crisp with a complex, long finish which means less oak and the right amount of ML.

We're excited to introduce new varietals in the coming three years, all of which will excel in the Oregon climate as well as in the McMinnville AVA terroir. Albariño, Cabernet Franc, Syrah and Chenin Blanc are all coming soon, as is Sparkling.

It's our version of a reserve wine, made from the very best barrels from each vintage. We won't always make an "Ultra Violet" but when we do, it won't disappoint. Our first Ultra Violet was our 2021 Chardonnay and in December 2022, we bottled our first Ultra Violet Pinot noir made from our 2021 estate fruit. In early October, we identified the two best barrels and when we brought them together, it was absolute perfection! When we first poured it in January 2023 at First Taste Oregon, it was awarded the Gold Medal for Best Pinot Noir!

We've spent the first three years building inventory and are just now offering our wines in our online store and in our tasting room. Soon you will find our wines in restaurants and clubs starting locally in Oregon, as well as back home in Ohio.
