

2024 CHENIN BLANC

Rogue Valley, Oregon



THE WINE

The little black dress of the white wine world- and this one is worthy of that title. Our elegant Chenin Blanc is seducing to the senses with notes of quince, linden blossom and tangerine.

THE VINEYARD

Anya Ranch Vineyard is in the Rouge Valley AVA in Talent, Oregon. Planted in 2020, the vines are grown at an elevation of 1850 feet above sea level in soils of Manita and Debenger-Brader loams.

VINTAGE

In the Rogue Valley AVA, 2024 turned out to be a very good vintage marked by a slower, cooler start to the Spring followed by warm, favorable conditions through Summer and into early Fall. High growing-degree-day totals, minimal extreme weather or wildfire smoke, plus cool nights later in the season, allowed grapes to ripen fully while retaining good natural acidity.

WINEMAKER'S COMMENTS

The fruit was hand-sorted, pressed and then settled overnight. The Chenin Blanc was then fermented and aged in neutral French oak. Lees stirring occurred weekly to increase complexity and introduce texture and autolytic notes.

TASTING NOTES

The wine unveils aromas and flavors of quince, peach and tangerine zest. Nuances of golden delicious apples are also present on the palate, accented by white linden flower and eucalyptus.
